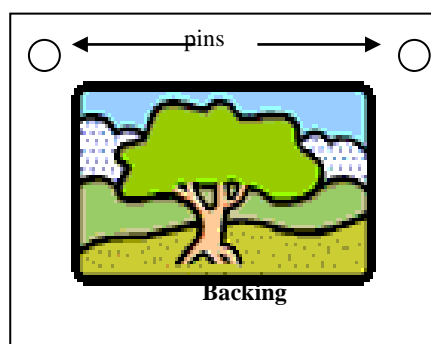

- All prints must be mounted on mounting boards or black card. Use double sided tape NOT glue. Use ½ a sheet of black 200gsm card per image.
- The exhibitors name and address must NOT appear on the front of the mount. The thickness of print mount should be restricted to 5mm for ease of fixing to display boards. Entries must not be framed with or without glass.
- Size of mounts should not exceed those specified otherwise entries **will not** be accepted.
- Please affix your image firmly to your mount with double sided tape NOT glue.
- If you are not sure please ring a steward for clarification.
- Entries can be nominated and dropped off at the show office the week prior to show day.

ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE COLLECTED AFTER THE SHOW

- Outdoor photographs of people and animals are best taken on an overcast day.
- The best time to take photographs is before 10.00am or after 4.00pm.
- Move in close to your subject.
- When taking seascapes, check that the horizon is level.
