### **SPECIAL REGULATIONS**

- **Entries** are what you **write on the form** and take to the office (and receive a "**Receipt of Entry**").
- **Exhibit** is the **article** you bring into the Show. Good luck!
- Exhibits that have previously taken a prize at the Busselton Show shall not be eligible to compete, and any that have been laundered (with the exception of *Classes 2*) will be disqualified.
- Fibres other than wool will be accepted in their appropriate classes.
- This section is open to amateurs only.
- Exhibit tickets must be either stitched on the exhibit or secured with small safety pins – **NO SEWING PINS TO BE USED.**

## EMBROIDERY SECTION

### **SPECIAL AWARDS:**

- The **Needles and Friends Group** has donated a cash prize to be awarded for the most outstanding piece of embroidery.

**NOTE:** All pictures must be properly backed and be ready to hang.

### **Class**

- 1 Any article on fabric using embroidery thread but not cross-stitch.
- 2 Any article handwoven.
- 3 Embroidered cushion (filled) any type of embroidery.
- 4 Any article in crewel work or wool embroidery, eg baby blanket.
- 5 Needlepoint tapestry picture – framed (see note above).
- 6 Cross-stitch picture – framed (see note above).
- 7 Long-stitch picture – framed (see note above).
- 8 Any other type of contemporary needlework for which a class has not been provided.
- 9 Any article hand made lace (bobbin, needlelace or knitted).
- 10 Any article in tatting.

EMBROIDERY SECTION (continued)

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- 11 Any article of beaded work.
  - 12 Any article featuring raised embroidery (includes Brazilian embroidery, stump work and Elizabethan).
  - 13 Any article in candle wicking
  - 14 Any article in ribbon embroidery.
  - 15 Any other framed article.
  - 16 Machine Embroidery – Freehand embroidery, any technique.
  - 17 Machine Embroidery – Computerized embroidery.
  - 18 Machine Embroidery – Combination of 2 or more of the above techniques.

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## KNITTED SECTION

Baby's garments must be knitted in baby yarn no thicker than 5-ply and fit a baby under 12 months.

***Class***

- 19 Youth 14-17 years of age – Any kind of knitted article.
- 20 Novice (knitting less than 2 years) - Any knitted article.
- 21 Baby's shawl. Approx 114cm square.
- 22 Baby's jacket.
- 23 Baby's set – jacket, bonnet and booties.
- 24 Cot cover. Approx 110cm x 120cm.
- 25 Child's jumper or cardigan, 10 years & under.
- 26 Lady's or Man's jumper, cardigan or sleeveless vest.
- 27 Knee rug not more than 1.2 metres square.
- 28 Beanie or Scarf.
- 29 Doll or toy animal, whole article must be knitted.
- 30 Tea Cosy.
- 31 Any article of knitting, not scheduled (wool, acrylic or cotton).

- 32 Youth 14-17 years of age – any crocheted article

- 34 Cot cover, approx 110cm x 120cm.
- 35 Any Baby's article.
- 36 Children's or Adult Garment.
- 37 Beanie, Scarf or Gloves.
- 38 Any article in Cotton.
- 39 Doll or Toy.
- 40 Cushion.
- 41 Knee Rug, less than 130cm in any direction.
- 42 Blanket.
- 43 Any article in crochet not scheduled, (wool, acrylic or cotton).

**Class**

- 57 Youth 14-17 Years of age – Quilt.
- 58 Youth 14-17 Years of age – Any other quilted article (eg. Bag, cushion, wallhanging).
- 59 Novice (less than 2 years quilting) Any other quilted article.
- 60 Quilt, more than 75cm on each side, mainly pieced, combination of hand and machine work.
- 61 Quilt, more than 75cm on each side, machine pieced and quilted.
- 62 Quilt, more than 75cm on each side, predominantly applique (hand or machine).

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- 63 Quilt, more than 75cm on each side, hand or machine pieced, longarm/professionally quilted.
  - 64 Quilt, any size, featuring hand stitchery.
  - 65 Quilt, any size, featuring Foundation Piecing technique.
  - 66 Wall hanging or art quilt, any technique.
  - 67 Table runner.
  - 68 Christmas article.
  - 69 Small quilt, no more than 50cm in either direction.
  - 70 Bag, cushion or any other pieced and quilted article.
  - 71 Quilt Challenge, themed '**Year of the Environment – Reduce, Reuse & Recycle**'. Maximum of 50cm in any direction, to be bound quilt finished depicting the "theme" of the class. Please provide a written description of the theme interpretation to display with the item.
