NOVICE

Any exhibitor with no more than two years experience and has not placed first in the woodwork section at the Busselton Show.

- 1 Any article, not turned
- 2 Any article, turned
- 3 Any article, wood carving
- 4 Any other article woodcraft

OPEN

Open to all entrants

- 5 Any article small furniture, no larger than 900mm
- 6 Lidded box, any method woodworking
- 7 Any item featuring more than one method of wood working
- 8 Turned bowl, no larger than 300mm diameter
- 9 Turned Bowl over 300mm, height over 80mm
- 10 Any turned platter (flat), over 300mm up to 600mm in diameter, height less than 70mm
- 11 Any lamp, no shade
- 12 Any 3 small items turned items eg 3 vases, 3 napkin rings
- 13 Turned walking or hiking stick
- 14 Any other item made from wood not included in schedule

WOODWORKING WITH A DISABILITY

Open to any exhibitor with a disability

- 15 Any article of woodcraft

Entrants should not work professionally in the craft

SPECIAL AWARDS:

- 16 Any practical metal work item
- 17 Any decorative metal work item, no larger than 900mm

- 18 Any item that combines wood and metal work, no more than 900mm base. No height restriction. Please provide dimensions on entry form for space allocation.
